Join us at Deluxe Tip Beach for a true celebration of Maldivian food and culture. Indulge in local short eats, salads, breads, curries and grilled seafood accompanied by authentic dips and sauces all homemade by a team of experienced cooks from our neighboring islands.

The stars of the event are the cooks, a group of Maldivian women from Fenfushi. The noncommercial chefs spend their time cooking for special events such as weddings and religious celebrations being held on their

island, some of which have over 500 guests in attendance. In an effort to support local industry while also finding creative ways to immerse guest's in local island culture, the resort team reached out to the group of women through team members from Fenfushi. The women will travel up to 30 minutes by boat to the resort to showcase their culinary culture at Maldivian Night.

All the women are present at the event and will prepare the fresh salads and the famous **Maldivian Lonu Mirus** (a chilli paste made of grated coconut, onion, garlic, cumin, black pepper, curry leaves, lime juice and fresh chilli) at the live cooking stations.

The experience is made complete with displays of arts and crafts, traditional palm leaf weaving and a live Bodu Beru performance.
